

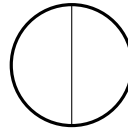

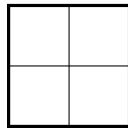

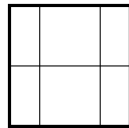

2. Put an **X** on the shape that is **NOT** cut into four equal parts.

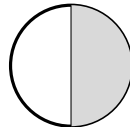

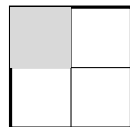

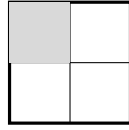
