1. The point of intersection of the coordinate axes is called:

3. The distance of the point $(3, 5)$ from the x-axis is:

4. Points $(-3, 5)$ and $(3, -5)$ lie in which quadrants respectively?
(a) II and IV (b) II and II (c) IV and II (d) III and I
5. Abscissa of all points on the y-axis is:
(a) 1 (b) Any number (c) 0 (d) -1

Section B: Short Answer Questions (2 Marks Each)

6. Write the coordinates of the points $A, B, C,$ and D from a Cartesian plane where:
 - A is 3 units to the left of y-axis and 2 units above x-axis.
 - B lies on the x-axis at a distance of 5 units to the right.
7. Find the coordinates of a point whose ordinate is -5 and which lies on the y-axis.
8. In which quadrant or on which axis do the following points lie? $(4, -2), (-3, -5), (0, 3), (7, 0)$.
9. Plot the points $P(1, 0), Q(4, 0),$ and $S(1, 3)$. Find the coordinates of point R such that $PQRS$ is a square.

Section C: Long Answer Questions (4 Marks Each)

10. Plot the following points on a graph paper: $A(2, 5)$, $B(-2, 2)$, $C(4, 2)$. Join these points to form a triangle. Find the area of the triangle ABC .
11. A point M is at a distance of 5 units from the x-axis and 7 units from the y-axis. Write the coordinates of M if it lies in the: (a) 2nd Quadrant (b) 3rd Quadrant (c) 4th Quadrant (d) 1st Quadrant.
12. Plot the points $A(-2, -2)$, $B(3, -2)$, $C(3, 3)$, and $D(-2, 3)$. Join them in order and identify the figure formed. Find its perimeter.
13. Write the coordinates of the vertices of a rectangle whose length and breadth are 6 and 3 units respectively, one vertex is at the origin, the longer side lies on the x-axis and one of the vertices lies in the second quadrant.

Section D: True or False (1 Mark Each)

Determine whether each of the following statements is true or false:

1. The ordinate of a point is its perpendicular distance from the y-axis.
2. The point $(0, 0)$ lies on both the x-axis and the y-axis.
3. A point whose both coordinates are negative lies in the III quadrant.
4. The distance of the point (a, b) from the y-axis is $|a|$.

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
